

Throughout literally hundreds of churches, if an individual were to ask a saved Christian on how many judgments there are in the Bible, they would give the wrong answer. Some would think the question is weird, others would not know anything about that, and several would figure that is not important at all. Many would teach only one judgment, which they may call the Judgment of God. That is why they changed "the judgment seat of Christ" in the King James Bible into something like "the judgment of God" or "the judgment of the Lord." They do not realize what the big deal was when they changed those words! What they did is that they took away the idea that there is another judgment, not just one, which is the Judgment Seat of Christ. In the Bible, there are actually seven judgments. However, thousands of saved Christians think there is only one judgment, which divides the saved from the lost. Absolutely wrong! "Doesn't the judgment for the sheep and the goat in Matthew 25 divide the Christians from non-Christians?" "Where are the angels right now and when will they be judged?"
