These are the doctrines that are most essential to Christianity above any other doctrine. Our belief rests or falls on these last events of our Savior. If Jesus did not die on the cross, then all of the world is doomed for hell. If Jesus did not rise from the dead, then our faith is in vain. If Jesus did not ascend, then the saints cannot gain the blessings of Heaven. Despite of Calvary being the greatest event for every lost sinner, there are critics attempting to refute the sacrifice of Christ. Although the resurrection is the greatest evidence ever to prove our Christian religion, there are skeptics attempting to crush this irrefutable fact that happened 2,000 years ago. This study will cover many details of the crucifixion, resurrection, and ascension of the Lord Jesus Christ and will answer questions such as, "Was Jesus Christ crucified on a cross or a stake?" "Why do we discourage the use of crosses?" "How can a few hours of suffering at Calvary satisfy the eternal suffering of our sins?" "Wouldn't the death of Christ discourage dedicated religious people to stop their good works and encourage them to sin?" "What are the strong evidences that support the resurrection of Christ?" "How do you honestly know that this is not a myth handed down by the ancients?" " What if the disciples were lying about the resurrection?" "Wouldn't you consider someone to be psychologically crazy if he told you that he saw your dead grandmother walking alive?"
