To the precious Muslims holding their beliefs sincerely, they know that their beliefs all rely on the man Muhammed. The reason is because all the teachings from the Koran are written by Muhammed, who is known as the greatest among the prophets. Islam also recognize that Jesus is a prophet in their religion as well. By comparing the Koran and Biblical history, let us see if Muhammed or Jesus should be the one to acknowledge for truth.

1) Muhammed married a six-year-old girl named Aisha and lusted after other little girls as well.

Some of the greatest Muslim scholars recorded: "The Messenger of Allah said, when he saw Um Habib bint Abbas, while she was yet an infant: 'When she reaches the age while I am alive, I will marry her.' At that time, she was three years old, and he was sixty.' He died two years later, wishing that she were six or nine years old, as Aisha was, so he could have married her. I am not fabricating these things against someone who was my own prophet at one time. Rather, these things were the cause of my alienation away from him and his alleged prophethood. You can read what Ibn Hajar wrote in his book, as well as what Imam As-Suhaili recorded" (Al-Isaba fi tamyiz al-Sahaba, Vol. IV, p.422; Rawd al-Unuf, Vol. III, p.66).

2) Muhammed lusted and married his daughter-in-law.

The great Muslim Imam named Al-Zamkhashri revealed, "The Messenger of Allah saw Zainab, after he gave her in marriage to Zayd, and he fell in love with her, and said, Praise Allah, who changes things" (Christ, Muhammed, and I, by Mohammed Al Ghazoli, p.42).

Zainab described after divorcing Muhammed's son, "After the divorce, immediately, and behold, the prophet of Allah entered my house while I was without a head-cover, and I asked him, 'Is it going to be like this without a guardian or a witness?' He answered me, 'Allah is the guardian and 'Gabriel' is the witness.'" As a result of his statement, Zainab boasted in front of Muhammad's other wives, saying: 'Your fathers gave you in marriage, but as for me, it was heaven who gave me in marriage, to the Messenger of Allah'" (The Jurisprudence of the Life of Muhammed by Sa'id 'Ashur, p. 126; Al-Isaba fi tamyiz al-Sahaha by Ibn Hjar Asqaliani, Vol. IV, p. 307).

3) Muhammed killed the husband of Safiya (a Jewish teenager) and immediately married her by force.

The respected Muslim leader Ghazoli showed, "Muhammad's fourth marriage was to Safiya, the daughter of Huyay, the Jew...When Muhammad entered into Safiya, she was only seventeen years old, in her first month of marriage to Kinana, whom Muhammad had ordered to be killed. At that time Muhammad was sixty-two years old" (Christ, Muhammad, and I, by Mohammad Al Ghazoli, pp. 46-47).

4) Muhammad stole and forcibly married a Christian's wife for confronting him.

Ubayd-Allah confronted Muhammad and said to him: "You are not a prophet nor a messenger of Allah. Stop claiming that. I am a believer in Christ for He is the Truth, but you are a self-conceited man." Ubayd was forced to leave, and Muhammad married his wife, Umm Habiba, to plant sorrow and sadness in his heart. At that time, Umm Habiba was a beautiful woman, twenty-three years old (The Wives of the Prophet by bint Al-Shati', p. 203).

5) Muhammad married Maymuna bint Al-Harith during the Pilgrimage, which is strictly forbidden in Koran 2:197.

Ibn Hisham said, "Ibn Ishaq said that the Messenger of Allah married Maymuna during his journey (pilgrimage), and that is illegal, and the one that officiated was Abbas Ibn Abd Al-Muttalib" (The Life of the Prophet by Ibn Hisham, Vol. III, p. 202).

- 6) Muhammad wrote that he is just a human still in the grave. But Jesus is the living God. Muhammad wrote that Jesus is a prophet who has God's revelations with the power to rise Himself from the dead. The Bible says that Jesus is the Lord whom everyone will bow.
- Muhammad: "I am only a human like you" (Koran 18:110).
 Jesus: "It said, 'Verily, I am the servant of God; He hath given me revelation and made me a prophet; And He hath made me blessed wherever I may be, and hath enjoined me prayer and almsgiving so long as I shall live; And to be duteous to her that bare me: and he hath not made me proud, depraved. And the peace of God was on me the day I was born, and will be the day I shall die, and the day I shall be raised to life.' This is Jesus the son of Mary; this is a statement of the truth concerning which they doubt" (Koran 19:30-34).

 "That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth,

and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (Philippians 2:10-11).

- 7) Muhammad wrote that he only gave two signs: his message (the Koran) and Allah not killing him since he never said any falsehood. But Muhammad and the Bible say that Jesus had miraculous signs of creating life, giving sight to the blind, making the lame walk, and raising people from the dead.
- **Muhammad:** "Thus have we sent down the Book of the Koran to thee: and they to whom we have given the Book of the law believe in it: and of these Arabians there are those who believe in it: and none, save the Infidels, reject our signs...And they say, 'Unless a sign be sent down to him from his Lord...' SAY: Signs are in the power of God alone. I am only a plain spoken warner" (Koran 29:47-50).

"And that it is not the word of a poet—how little do ye believe! Neither is it the word of a soothsayer (Kahin)—how little do ye receive warning! It is a missive from the Lord of the worlds. But if Muhammad had fabricated concerning us any sayings, We had surely seized him by the right hand, and had cut through the vein of his neck" (Koran 69:41).

• **Jesus:** "When He shall say: O Jesus! Son of Mary! Call to mind my favour upon thee and upon thee and upon thy mother, when I strengthened thee with the Holy Spirit, that thou shouldest speak to men alike in the cradle, and when grown up And when I taught thee the Scripture, and Wisdom, and the Law, and the Evangel: and thou didst breathe into it, and by my leave it became a bird; and thou didst heal the blind and the leper, by my leave, and when, by my leave, thou didst bring forth the dead" (Koran 5:109-110).

"And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people" (John 9:35).

- 8) Muhammad wrote there is no place of repentance for dying sinners despite of how much they want to. But Jesus forgave dying sinners.
- **Muhammad:** "But no place of repentance shall there be for those who do evil, until, when death is close to one of them, he saith, 'Now verily am I turned to God;' nor to those who die unbelievers. These! We have made ready for them a grievous torment!" (Koran 4:18)
- **Jesus:** A thief being crucified beside Christ, "Said unto Jesus, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, Verily I say unto thee, to day shalt thou be with me in paradise" (Luke 23:42,43).

May I ask the dear Muslims to whom will they acknowledge for truth? Muhammad? Or Jesus? Muhammad admitted that he was a man without a compassionate heart for dying sinners. The Koran, Muslim scholars, and history reveal that Muhammad had serious problems and sins in his marriage life. But Muhammad admitted that Jesus Christ had the power to create life, heal all diseases, and raise the dead. Because of the great amount of evidences, Muhammad cannot deny the power of Jesus. Biblical history shows that Jesus Christ is God to accept as Savior. Will you choose Jesus Christ for your salvation?
