No. Science and everyone know this cannot be true. The planet sun is bigger than the earth, and it cannot land on a muddy spring without burning the whole earth to the ground!

2) Do babies come from man's loins and breastbones?

Yes. "Over every soul is set a guardian. Let man then reflect out of what he created. He was created. He was created of the poured-forth germs, Which issue from the loins and breastbones" (Koran 86:4).
