THE BIBLE SAYS

Man is not, nor ever will be a god

“God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent:...”Numbers 23:19

“...for I am God, and not man;...” Hosea 11:9

“...for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me,” Isaiah 46:9

It is important to not that it was Satan who first introduced this lie through the serpent to mankind that man could become a god. (Gen.3). It was this same sin that got him, (Lucifer) cast out of heaven, whose destiny is the lake of fire. (Isaiah 14 & Rev. 20)

God is a Spirit

The Jesus of Mormonism

Mormonism Worships a Different Christ

Is the Jesus of the Bible the same as the Jesus of Mormonism?

The Jesus of the Bible

Born of a Virgin and Conceived by the Holy Ghost

“Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to

Joseph, before they came together, **she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.**” Matthew 1:18 (See also Isaiah 7:14 & Luke 1:26-35)

Not married

Jesus attended a marriage at Cana, but only as a guest. (John 2:1-11). There are no references in the Bible that God The Father or Jesus were ever married.

If marriage and/or polygamy were such an important issue, then God would have given in many indications that He was married, to one and/or multiple wives.

Jesus warns, “For there shall arise **false Christs**, And **false prophets**, and shall shew great signs and wonders;...Behold, **I have told you** before.” Matthew 24:24—25

The Mormon Gospel

The Gospel

We have **another Biblical warning** her about those who would preach another gospel. “but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ.

MORMONISM SAYS

Salvation by Works, Faith and Grace

Two Types of Salvation in Mormonism

General

“...general salvation,...consists in the mere fact of being resurrected.” “Immortality is a free gift and comes without works or righteousness of any sort; all men will come forth in the resurrection because of the atoning sacrifice of Christ...Immortality comes by grace alone, but those who gain it may find themselves damned in eternity.”

Individual

“...that which comes by grace coupled with gospel obedience,...This kind of salvation follows faith, repentance, baptism, receipt of the Holy Ghost, and continued righteousness to the end of one’s mortal probation.” Mormon Doctrine by Bruce R. McConkie, p. 669-670

THE BIBLE SAYS

Salvation by Grace through Faith

“For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of

works, lest any man should boast.” Ephesians 2:8-9

“Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ,...for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.” Galatians 2:16 & 21

The Lord Jesus shared many good examples of God’s grace to sinful man...In Luke 18:9-14 Jesus spoke of two men that went to the temple to pray.

A Pharisee and a publican.

The Pharisee was a very religious man who had a **special priesthood, special garments, a temple** and did many religious works.

The publican was a tax collector, many times extorting money from those he collected taxes from.

The Pharisee gloried in his religious works.

The publican, humbly asked, “

God be merciful to me a sinner

.” And Jesus said that it was the publican that went home justified or forgiven that day, not the religious Pharisee.

(Also see Luke 23:32-43)

“Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:” Romans 3:24

MORMONISM SAYS

THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO CLEANSE FROM SIN

“Joseph Smith taught that there were **certain sins** so grievous that man may commit, that

they will place the transgressors beyond the power of the atoning blood of Christ.

If these offenses are committed, then the blood of Christ will not cleanse them from their sins even though they repent.

Therefore their
only hope is to have their own blood shed to atone,
as far as possible, in their behalf.”

THE BIBLE SAYS

Concerning the Blacks
